



### **Statement of the Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive**

FormFactor is committed to ensuring that our products and operations comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations. As a global company, this commitment includes meeting the requirements of Directive 2011/65/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (recast). FormFactor is in compliance with the European RoHS Directive, which is also commonly referred to as “RoHS 2”.

FormFactor wafer probe cards are custom products specifically designed as a part of a semiconductor test cell, which includes semiconductor equipment classified as “large scale stationary industrial tools”. Large scale stationary industrial tools are out of scope of RoHS 2 under Article 2.4(d) of the directive. Consequently, FormFactor wafer probe cards are out of scope of RoHS 2 as “equipment which is specifically designed, and is to be installed, as part of another type of equipment that is excluded or does not fall within the scope of this Directive, which can fulfil its function only if it is part of that equipment, and which can be replaced only by the same specifically designed equipment”. See, Article 4.2(c) of RoHS 2.

FormFactor regularly monitors its compliance with environmental laws, rules, and regulations and will update this Statement as appropriate.
